### **WHO WE ARE**

ADDI, the African Diaspora Development Institute is an entity that is designed to be the bridge between all people of African descent living outside Africa (African Diaspora) and their brothers and sisters on the continent.

### **MISSION**

- To promote unity among the African diaspora and to encourage them to participate in the development of Africa.
- To educate the African diaspora about investment opportunities in Africa
- To promote the African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA) to the African diaspora.

### **GOALS**

- All African Diaspora families participate in the ADDI Fund to build Africa.



The African Diaspora Development Institute (ADDI) is an entity that was born out of the realization that there is no one-stop-shop for everything African. Business Communities around the world, African Diaspora, or people interested in African tourism have to visit 55 African countries in order to find out information about Africa. There's definitely a need for a one-stop organization where people can go to get information about Africa.

In addition, realizing that African economic status is what it is today because of the massive exodus of Africa's manpower through the brain drain that has occurred over the past 400 years starting with slavery followed by the most recent immigrants who left Africa in search of greener pastures with the majority who came out to the United States or Europe or the Asian countries for Education.

Regardless of the reasons for migration, the end result is that Africa does not have the capacity that it needs to build the Africa that we want. More importantly, now that we are in the era of the African Continental Free-Trade Area, it is imperative that the children of Africa in the Diaspora return home to Africa and join their brothers and sisters on the continent to build the Africa that we want.

The plan is to start the development of each region through the building of an African Diaspora Center of Excellence, aka Wakanda One Smart City. Each center of excellence will be a developmental hub for each region from which development will spread throughout the region.

The same approach will be applied in every sector. Each center is going to be pillared on a University system with an emphasis on healthcare, education and capacity building of skilled workforce, entrepreneurs and innovators.

The conditions on the ground in Africa demand that education be responsible and designed to equip the workforce with the necessary tools to meet today as well as future workforce needs.

Priority will be given to training the capacity needed to develop regional infrastructure and agriculture.


In a nutshell, the Center of Excellence will develop into a first-class city which will be the developmental hub for the region.

- Chairperson Moussa Faki Mahamat. Re elected incumbent. ( TD Chad-Central Region)
- Deputy Chairperson of the Commission Monique Nsanzabaganwa. ( rw Rwanda - Eastern Region)



# **JUST FACTS**

The first and still standing Black University was founded in Timbuktu. This hallowed institution is called the **University of Sankoré**. The **Sankoré** Mosque was founded in 989 AD in the country today known as **Mali**.

Mali was part of the ancient African Songhai Empire, one of the most powerful Kingdoms in the known world. Itwas located in the city of Timbuktu, a lynchpin in the trades of salt, gold, and other goods to the Arab, African and European powers of the time. That mosque would become known as the University of Sankoré and was so well known that it was added to maps produced in Europe.

# SECTOR SPOTLIGHT ADDI Digital & Information Technology

The ADDI Information & Digital Technology Sector was introduced to the African Diaspora on January 9, 2021. ADDI Founder and CEO, Her Excellency Ambassador Arikana Chihombori-Quao, and Sector Director Jote Taddese led the sector introduction via online webinar by outlining their purpose and strategic objectives.

The Digital Technology Sector will be the cornerstone of broader ADDI objectives by mobilizing the leadership, human capital and expertise needed to implement digital technology capabilities. Leveraging new and emerging technologies accelerates the implementation of the Continental Development Plan of the African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA)

Since its formation, the Digital Technology Sector has onboarded a Digital Network Platform called Social Africa. The mission of Social Africa is to create digital content tailored to tell the story of Africa and the Diaspora. Social Africa believes that in the next decade, the availability and use of social media platforms will be the single most predictable measure of societal and economic prosperity across Africa.

The Digital Technology Sector continues to seek out and mobilize African innovators and entrepreneurs with established digital solutions and services for the African market. In February, the ADDI IT Sector introduced a Pan-African Digital Currency and Blockchain Network called Oduwa Coins. The term Oduwa means "Roadmap to Wealth" and was founded by an African Diaspora member. During the same webinar, a new training opportunity was announced for the African Diaspora to participate in sponsoring African Youth to be trained by a partnering Cyber Security Training Academy, also founded by an African Diaspora member.

These solutions are intended to help bring economic and financial inclusion for the masses in Africa.
